**Religious Ed News**

-Confirmation sponsors and parents rallied in support of their confirmandi. All second year classes held a "meet and greet" class, where the sponsors were taught along with the students. This sponsors night featured a mass, a rite of acceptance for both students and sponsors and a class aimed at solidifying their importance. The class followed with light refreshments and each student was asked to introduce themselves and their sponsors to the teacher and other classmates. All told, it was a successful evening with the goal of keeping the students in the faith long after Confirmation is over.

-Catechism students are decorating crosses with poems, thank you notes or pictures for our Good Friday outdoor Stations of the Cross. Every year, the 2 crosses outside of CCD reflect our students best hopes for Lent. Be sure to catch this one time only attraction with weather permitting visitors to witness the students artwork.

**Catechism Corner by Kacey Carey, DRE**

"The Palm Sunday narrative has always confused me. On the one hand, we have Jesus' triumphant entry amidst accolades and Hosannas one week. And on the other hand, 5 days later, the crowd is yelling for Christ's crucifixion. This juxtaposition points to our own fickleness concerning faith. One time we are contrite and seek forgiveness through Confession. The next time we are repeating the same sins and deliberately offending God. We know in our hearts how lonely we are without our Creator, yet we can't seem to stay on the straight and narrow path. Our concupiscence makes us drift away from doing the right thing to doing the easy thing. We know we should be more prayerful during Lent. Yet when a tantalizing distraction comes our way, we "forget" to pray, go to mass, give alms or fast. We can "fill in the blank" with whatever compromises our will to obey God. The hardest thing to realize is when we stray from God, we are the ones shouting for Christ's death. We are the ones content to let Him take the blame for our sins. This realization that we can so easily turn our backs to God means our faith is weak.

Let us ask God to shore up our resolve, to call us back to return again and again. Let us align our lives more closely with Him through prayer, fasting, and generous giving. With His grace, may we live Lent fully and move with transformed hearts into the abundant life of Easter morning.

**Rincón de Catecismo por Kacey Carey, DRE**

"La narrativa del Domingo de Ramos siempre me ha confundido. Por un lado, tenemos la entrada triunfal de Jesús en medio de elogios y Hosannas una semana. Y por otro lado, 5 días después, la multitud grita por la crucifixión de Cristo. Esta yuxtaposición apunta a nuestra propia inconstancia con respecto a la fe. Una vez nos arrepentimos y buscamos el perdón a través de la Confesión. La próxima vez estamos repitiendo los mismos pecados y ofendiendo deliberadamente a Dios. Sabemos en nuestros corazones lo solos que estamos sin nuestro Creador, pero parece que no podemos permanecer en el camino recto y angosto. Nuestra concupiscencia nos hace alejarnos de hacer lo correcto para hacer lo fácil. Sabemos que debemos orar más durante la Cuaresma. Sin embargo, cuando se nos presenta una distracción tentadora, nos "olvidamos" de orar, ir a misa, dar limosna o ayunar. Podemos "llenar el espacio en blanco" con cualquier cosa que comprometa nuestra voluntad de obedecer a Dios. Lo más difícil de darse cuenta es que cuando nos alejamos de Dios, somos nosotros los que clamamos por la muerte de Cristo. Nosotros somos los que estamos contentos de dejar que Él cargue con la culpa de nuestros pecados. Esta comprensión de que podemos darle la espalda a Dios tan fácilmente significa que nuestra fe es débil.

Pidámosle a Dios que refuerce nuestra determinación, que nos llame a volver una y otra vez. Alineemos nuestras vidas más estrechamente con Él a través de la oración, el ayuno y la generosidad. Con Su gracia, que vivamos la Cuaresma plenamente y avancemos con corazones transformados hacia la vida abundante de la mañana de Pascua.
