Transfer to AF flight 4486 departing at 6:25pm for Morocco. Arrive Morocco at 8:45pm. Meet our guide and driver after baggage claim and customs for ride to Fes.</p> <p>Day 3 - Tuesday, October 31, 2023 Fes After breakfast, we enjoy time in Fes before traveling to a Moroccan lunch at a traditional restaurant in the Medina. We spend the afternoon sightseeing in Fes, including the Medieval Medina, Nejjarine soukain, the Moulay Ismail mausoleum, Karouine mosque, and a Koranic school. Return to hotel for dinner and overnight.</p> <p>Day 4 - Wednesday, November 1, 2023 Volubilis - Meknes - Rabat After breakfast, we depart Fes for a ride to view the impressive ruins of the Roman city of Volubilis via the holy city of Moulay Ismail. Continue on to Meknes to visit the Ismailian capital, the Bab Mansour, the Royal Stables and the Jewish Quarter before lunch at a typical Moroccan restaurant. We then continue to Rabat for a city tour, including the Royal Palace, the Oudaya Kasbah, the Mohammed V mausoleum and the Hassan Tower. Back to our hotel for dinner and overnight.</p> <p>Day 5 - Thursday, November 2, 2023 Rabat - Marrakech After breakfast, we drive to Marrakech with lunch</p>

at a local restaurant. Afternoon, we visit the Bahia Palace. We then explore the colorful alleys and handcraft quarters and the famous Djemaa El Fna square. Back to our hotel for dinner, a show and over night.

Day 6 - Friday, November 3, 2023
Marrakech - Casablanca
 After breakfast, we see the The Saint Laurent museum and art galleries, then drive to Casablanca. Following lunch we visit the Hassan II mosque, the central market, Habous district, Royal Palace, Mohammed V square and Anfa. Dinner and overnight in our hotel.

Day 7 - Saturday, November 4, 2023
Chefchaouen - Tangier
 After breakfast and checkout, we head to Tangier via the Blu city (Chefchaouen) for some time at leisure to explore the city. We'll have lunch at a local restaurant, then continue to our hotel for dinner and overnight.

Day 8 - Sunday, November 5, 2023
Algeiras - Granada
 After early morning breakfast and checkout, we take a ~90 minute ferry ride to Algeiras. From here we drive to Granada. Late afternoon we have some time at leisure in Granada before heading to our hotel for check in, dinner and overnight.

Day 9 - Sunday, November 6, 2023
Granada
 Today we enjoy a guided tour of the city, including the Alhambra, Generalife, the Abajain quarter, and Cathedral with the Real Chapel. The rest of the day is at leisure before heading back to our hotel for dinner, a fabulous Flamenco show and overnight.

Catechism Corner by Kacey Carey, DRE

The words "Corpus Christi" mean so much more than just the Body of Christ. The Eucharist is the source and summit of our faith as Catholics. But what separates us from our Protestant brothers and sisters is our belief that that tiny wafer really is the Body of Christ. In the gospel today we are reminded that the "hard saying" of Jesus drove many of his followers away. He said unless you eat of his flesh and drink of his blood, you have no life within you. Many understood exactly what Jesus meant by this. It is made even more clear by " whoever eats my flesh and drinks my blood has eternal life, and I will raise him on the last day. For my flesh is true food and my blood is true drink." Many were repulsed by the thought of cannibalism, but Christ unwaveringly insists that He is willing to feed us from his own body, so that we will become like him. If we seek true intimacy with him, we must imbibe him, thereby strengthening ourselves to resist evil. The Catholic church is the only church which has an authentic priesthood founded on St. Peter, and through apostolic succession can transubstantiate the Eucharist, transforming it into the Body and Blood of Jesus. We should be very proud to belong to a church which has 24/7 Eucharistic Adoration and draws many other parishes to itself. So let us partake in honoring this once a year feast day and process proudly that we belong to the church that Jesus established.

Rincón de Catecismo por Kacey Carey, DRE

¡Las palabras "Corpus Christi" significan mucho más que el Cuerpo de Cristo. La Eucaristía es la fuente y cumbre de nuestra fe como católicos. Pero lo que nos separa de nuestros hermanos y hermanas protestantes es nuestra creencia de que esa pequeña hostia es realmente el Cuerpo de Cristo. En el evangelio de hoy se nos recuerda que las "duras palabras" de Jesús ahuyentaron a muchos de sus seguidores. Él dijo que a menos que comas de su carne y bebas de su sangre, no tienes vida dentro de ti. Muchos entendieron exactamente lo que Jesús quiso decir con esto. Se hace aún más claro por "el que come mi carne y bebe mi sangre tiene vida eterna, y yo lo resucitaré en el último día. Porque mi carne es verdadera comida y mi sangre es verdadera bebida". A muchos les repugnaba la idea del canibalismo, pero Cristo insiste firmemente en que Él está dispuesto a alimentarnos de su propio cuerpo, para que lleguemos a ser como él. Si buscamos la verdadera intimidad con él, debemos empaparnos de él, fortaleciéndonos así para resistir el mal. La iglesia católica es la única iglesia que tiene un sacerdocio auténtico fundado en San Pedro, y por medio de la sucesión apostólica puede transubstanciar la Eucaristía, transformándola en el Cuerpo y la Sangre de Jesús. Deberíamos estar muy orgullosos de pertenecer a una iglesia que tiene adoración eucarística las 24 horas del día, los 7 días de la semana y atrae a muchas otras parroquias. Así que participemos en honrar este día de fiesta una vez al año y procesemos con orgullo que pertenecemos a la iglesia que Jesús estableció.

"Dios se da a cada uno de nosotros individualmente y quiere transformarnos a través de la comunión con él. Una vez que somos transformados, se supone que debemos transformar el mundo. Todo lo demás que es la Iglesia además de eso es secundario". YouCat 125,171,208
