You can easily access this so-called "Netflix of the Catholic Church" by going to the website or download the free app on your phone.

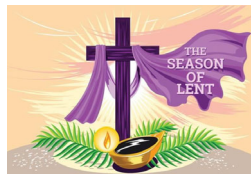

Religious Ed News

--The Religious Ed program encourages all families to participate in St. Bruno day at Planned Parenthood in RWC. Our day of prayer and witness begins on Saturday, April 1 all day at 2907 El Camino Real in RWC. Please contact the office for times you would like to participate or possible ride sharing. Research proves when people are praying in front of a clinic, 75% of the women fail to show up for their appointments.

-Our Free Bilingual Communion Retreat looms ahead on March 18 with many noted guest speakers , lunch and family activities centered on the Eucharist. We encourage full participation of students, families , grandparents and godparents . The First Communicant feels more fully supported when all the family is learning with him.

-Confirmation sponsors/godparents are needed for our Confirmation students with the ceremony scheduled for May 21 at 300pm. The purpose of a God-filled sponsor is to guide the student in pursuing the faith. Sponsors must be at least 16 years of age, already Confirmed and be practicing Catholics. If unmarried, they must be living a celibate lifestyle or if married, be married in the Catholic church. If they have children, the children must be raised in the Catholic faith. They can not be bound by any canonical penalty such as lacking annulment from a previous marriage. They must be attending church and the sacraments regularly. A ceremony is a day, a sacrament is a lifetime.

-El programa de Educación Religiosa alienta a todas las familias a participar en el día de San Bruno en Planned Parenthood en RWC. Nuestro día de oración y testimonio comienza el sábado 1 de abril todo el día en 2907 El Camino Real en RWC. Comuníquese con la oficina para conocer los horarios en los que le gustaría participar o si es posible compartir el viaje. La investigación demuestra que cuando las personas rezan frente a una clínica, el 75% de las mujeres no se presentan a sus citas.

-Nuestro Retiro de Comunión Bilingüe Gratuito se avecina el 18 de marzo con muchos oradores invitados destacados, almuerzo y actividades familiares centradas en la Eucaristía. Fomentamos la plena participación de alumnos, familias, abuelos y padrinos. El Primer Comunicante se siente más apoyado cuando toda la familia está aprendiendo con él.

-Se necesitan patrocinadores/padrinos de confirmación para nuestros estudiantes de Confirmación con la ceremonia programada para el 21 de mayo a las 300 p. m. El propósito de un padrino lleno de Dios es guiar al estudiante en la búsqueda de la fe. Los padrinos deben tener al menos 16 años de edad, estar ya confirmados y ser católicos practicantes. Si no están casados, deben vivir un estilo de vida célibe o si están casados, estar casados en la iglesia católica. Si tienen hijos, los hijos deben ser criados en la fe católica. No pueden estar obligados por ninguna pena canónica como la falta de nulidad de un matrimonio anterior. Deben asistir a la iglesia ya los sacramentos con regularidad. Una ceremonia es un día, un sacramento es toda una vida.



Catechism Corner by Kacey Carey, DRE

The word transfigure means to change in outwardly appearance, to alter or to transform in order to glorify or exalt. Imagine witnessing Jesus' transformation into a dazzling white robe and glowing appearance. "His face shown like the sun." The apostles James, John and Peter must have been astounded as they beheld the closest thing to the Beatific vision right before their eyes. God wanted to reveal Jesus' divine glory while he was still on earth so that the apostles could accept his death and resurrection more hopefully. And to also see Moses and Elijah conversing with Jesus was another shock. Moses represents the Law and Elijah represents the prophets, whereas Jesus brings both figures into fulfillment. And the final triumph was to heard God the Father declare "This is my beloved Son, with whom I am well pleased; listen to him." The command to listen to Jesus was first heard at Jesus baptism. And so we continue to listen to Jesus as he brings the law of the Ten Commandments into our everyday reality . We know that if we adhere to these rules, we will not fall away from God. And the prophets always heralded the coming of Jesus with predictions. They foretold his birth of a virgin, his meekness, his miracles and his passion, death and resurrection. No other founder of a world religion can duplicate the prophets predictions which are well documented , even by non-Catholics. We want our Lent to transfigure us to be more like Jesus. We want our small negligible sacrifices to be transformed into huge offertory oblations, ascending on high. We want our everyday penances to be considered by God as something worthy of Him. We want Christ to transfigure us into being more like Him and less like us.

Rincón de Catecismo por Kacey Carey, DRE

La palabra transfigurar significa cambiar de apariencia exterior, alterar o transformar para glorificar o exaltar. Imagínese ser testigo de la transformación de Jesús en una túnica blanca deslumbrante y una apariencia resplandeciente. "Su rostro se muestra como el sol". Los apóstoles Santiago, Juan y Pedro debieron quedar asombrados al contemplar lo más parecido a la visión beatífica ante sus ojos. Dios quiso revelar la gloria divina de Jesús mientras aún estaba en la tierra para que los apóstoles pudieran aceptar su muerte y resurrección con más esperanza. Y ver también a Moisés y Elías conversando con Jesús fue otro shock. Moisés representa la Ley y Elías representa a los profetas, mientras que Jesús da cumplimiento a ambas figuras. Y el triunfo final fue escuchar a Dios Padre declarar: "Este es mi Hijo amado, en quien tengo complacencia; escúchenlo". El mandato de escuchar a Jesús se escuchó por primera vez en el bautismo de Jesús. Y así continuamos escuchando a Jesús mientras trae la ley de los Diez Mandamientos a nuestra realidad cotidiana. Sabemos que si nos adherimos a estas reglas, no nos apartaremos de Dios. Y los profetas siempre anunciaron la venida de Jesús con predicciones. Predijeron su nacimiento de virgen, su mansedumbre, sus milagros y su pasión, muerte y resurrección. Ningún otro fundador de una religión mundial puede duplicar las predicciones de los profetas que están bien documentadas, incluso por los no católicos. Queremos que nuestra Cuaresma nos transfigure para ser más como Jesús. Queremos que nuestros pequeños e insignificantes sacrificios se transformen en grandes oblations de ofertorio, ascendiendo a lo alto. Queremos que nuestras penitencias cotidianas sean consideradas por Dios como algo digno de Él. Queremos que Cristo nos transfigure para ser más como Él y menos como nosotros.
