Should we be surprised that the apostles did not recognize Jesus walking on water? After all, despite his multiple miracles of multiplication of loaves, curing of the blind, lame and paralytics, the apostles still did not recognize Christ's divinity. Impetuous Peter, exclaimed "if it is you, call me. Even the handpicked first vicar of our church, doubted the "ghost" was Jesus. When the Lord said, "take courage, it is I", he quelled all their fears, reassuring them he was real. Peter only starts to sink when he takes his eyes off Jesus. And so it is with us, when we take our eyes off Jesus, we tend to falter. Despite all the times the Lord has blessed us, we still occasionally doubt his providence. Even when we directly see his intervention in our day to day concerns, we still fail to recognize his involvement. We tend to get bogged down in extraneous distractions, material worries, and fruitless pursuits. We tend to spend too much time "conversing" via social media and too little time conversing with the only medium that counts. We spend much time on "Face time", but too little face to face time with the Real Presence in the Blessed Sacrament. If only we could reorient ourselves to seek first Jesus, then all others, our lives would be so much more like his. We would have less doubts, more conviction, and less worry. We would have peace and most of all assurance that we were doing God's will for us. Let us keep our eyes on the prize.

Tendemos a pasar demasiado tiempo "conversando" a través de las redes sociales y muy poco tiempo conversando con el único medio que cuenta. Pasamos mucho tiempo en "tiempo cara a cara", pero muy poco tiempo cara a cara con la Presencia Real en el Santísimo Sacramento. Si pudiéramos reorientarnos para buscar primero a Jesús y luego a todos los demás, nuestras vidas serían mucho más como la suya. Tendríamos menos dudas, más convicción y menos preocupación. Tendríamos paz y sobre todo la seguridad de que estamos haciendo la voluntad de Dios para nosotros. Mantengamos nuestros ojos en el premio.
