**Catechism Corner by Kacey Carey, DRE**

What Jesus did on Mount Tabor is a foretaste of heaven. The Transfiguration is a pivotal moment in salvation history as Jesus tied the Old Testament to the New. He appeared to his trinity of apostles as transfigured before their eyes. He wanted Peter, James and John to be fortified against his coming death. He wanted them to be strengthened in steadfastness against the horrible death in which he would endure. He showed them what the future held if they would continue to follow him. His clothes became "white as light" and his face shone like the sun. The apparition of Moses represented the Law and Elijah represented the prophets, thus tying the Old Testament to the new. These two early saints deferred to Jesus, thus inspiring the apostles to honor him as divine. God the Father's voice further terrified them by saying "listen to him". Logically the apostles, were astounded and fearful. But Jesus said "rise, and do not be afraid". And the same goes for we mortals, when confronted with something we can not understand, we tend to fall back, become afraid or lose heart. But a glimpse of the beatific vision, was intended to change their fear into hope for the future. It was intended to fortify them against Christ's impending death. And the same goes for us, if we were to have a direct encounter with Christ, we could bear all trials. We could stand strong against adversity, fighting the good fight. Because we know that a temporary discomfort is passing, and the ultimate reward awaits. Most of us will not have a direct apparition of a transfigured Christ, but we can come close. We can talk to him in the Blessed Sacrament. We can ask him to transfigure (change) our lives to be more like his life.

Lo que Jesús hizo en el Monte Tabor es un anticipo del cielo. La Transfiguración es un momento crucial en la historia de la salvación, ya que Jesús vinculó el Antiguo Testamento con el Nuevo. Se apareció a su trinidad de apóstoles transfigurado ante sus ojos. Quería que Pedro, Santiago y Juan estuvieran fortalecidos contra su muerte venidera. Quería que se fortalecieran en la firmeza contra la horrible muerte que él sufriría. Les mostró lo que les deparaba el futuro si continuaban siguiéndolo. Su ropa se volvió "blanca como la luz" y su rostro resplandecía como el sol. La aparición de Moisés representaba la Ley y Elías representaba a los profetas, vinculando así el Antiguo Testamento con el nuevo. Estos dos primeros santos se remitieron a Jesús, inspirando así a los apóstoles. para honrarlo como divino. La voz de Dios Padre los aterrizó aún más al decir: "Escúchenlo". Lógicamente, los apóstoles, estaban atónitos y temerosos. Pero Jesús dijo: "Levántense y no tengan miedo". Y lo mismo ocurre con nosotros, los mortales., cuando nos enfrentamos a algo que no podemos entender, tendemos a retroceder, tener miedo o desanimarnos. Pero un atisbo de la visión beatífica tenía la intención de cambiar su miedo en esperanza para el futuro. Tenía la intención de fortalecerlos contra la voluntad de Cristo. muerte inminente, y lo mismo para nosotros, si tuviéramos un encuentro directo con Cristo, podríamos sobrellevar todas las pruebas, podríamos estar firmes contra la adversidad, peleando la buena batalla, porque sabemos que una incomodidad temporal está pasando, y la recompensa final espera. La mayoría de nosotros no tendremos una aparición directa de un Cristo transfigurado, pero podemos acercarnos. Podemos hablar con él en el Santísimo Sacramento. Podemos pedirle que transfigure (cambie) nuestras vidas para que se parezcan más a su vida.
