**Catechism Corner by Kacey Carey, DRE**

The parable of the sower rings true on several levels. At various times, all of us have been receptive, non receptive, too busy, too bored or too tired to listen to the word of God. The same word of God might sound hallow one day and ring true the next. It seems to center on our ability to attend to the message. Christ says "the seed sown on a path is like one who hears the word of the kingdom without understanding it. And the evil one comes and steals away what was sown in his heart". Pathways deter plants growing because of heavy traffic . Conversely, the seed sown on rocky ground is at first received joyfully, then trials or persecution come, falls away. This makes perfect sense as nothing can really grow on a smooth rock allowing water and soil to roll away. The final seed sown on rich soil proves beneficial to the one who hears and understands it. But timing and receptivity are key in understanding the word of God. We have to be willing to listen and put ourselves in the shoes of another, which can be difficult if we are not naturally altruistic. We can pray to the Holy Spirit to widen our grasp of what is read. We can spend time in contemplating the word so that we do clearly understand it. Most bibles have an explanation of a passage in the footnotes or can refer the reader to another similar passage. All these things help our understanding and thereby grow richly.

**Rincón de Catecismo por Kacey Carey, DRE**

¡La parábola del sembrador suena cierta en varios niveles. En varios momentos, todos nosotros hemos sido receptivos, no receptivos, demasiado ocupados, demasiado aburridos o demasiado cansados para escuchar la palabra de Dios. La misma palabra de Dios puede sonar santa un día y verdadera al día siguiente. Parece centrarse en nuestra capacidad de prestar atención al mensaje. Cristo dice que "la semilla sembrada en un camino es como quien oye la palabra del reino sin entenderla. Y viene el malo y roba lo que fue sembrado en su corazón". Los caminos impiden el crecimiento de las plantas debido al tráfico pesado. Por el contrario, la semilla sembrada en terreno pedregoso primero es recibida con gozo, luego vienen las pruebas o la persecución, se cae. Esto tiene mucho sentido ya que nada puede crecer realmente en una roca lisa que permita que el agua y el suelo se desplacen. La semilla final sembrada en tierra fértil resulta beneficiosa para el que la oye y la entiende. Pero el tiempo y la receptividad son claves para entender la palabra de Dios. Tenemos que estar dispuestos a escuchar y ponernos en el lugar del otro, lo cual puede ser difícil si no somos altruistas por naturaleza. Podemos orar al Espíritu Santo para que amplíe nuestra comprensión de lo que se lee. Podemos pasar tiempo contemplando la palabra para que la entendamos claramente. La mayoría de las biblias tienen una explicación de un pasaje en las notas al pie o pueden remitir al lector a otro pasaje similar. Todas estas cosas ayudan a nuestra comprensión y, por lo tanto, crecen ricamente.
