Catechism Corner by Kacey Carey, DRE

Even the least little thing we do for the Lord will be rewarded. Jesus says that "whoever gives only a cup of cold water to one of these little ones to drink because the little one is a disciple---amen, I say to you, he will surely not lose his reward." Our Lord wants us to freely give of our abundance to others in need as if we were giving to Our Lord Himself. Of particular value are the corporal and spiritual works of mercy. In these practical works, we have a chance to be Christ-like to others, not because we must , but because we freely want to give back to God, for all He has given us. To feed the hungry, give drink to the thirsty, clothe the naked, shelter the homeless , visit the sick and bury the dead, are the corporal (bodily) works. The individual spiritual works are practiced one on one, but just as powerful. These works are to instruct the ignorant, counsel the doubtful, comfort the sorrowful, admonish the sinner, bear wrongs patiently, forgive all injuries, and pray for the living and the dead. Instructing children in catechism is a great way to practice the first work and a good way to learn the faith ourselves. Teaching others means we ourselves are benefiting in that we reinforce what was read, heard and written. We ask our Confirmation students to practice all these works throughout their two years with us. Only by serving others, do we learn to serve God, think altruistically and step outside of ourselves. By doing for others , we "find ourselves", instead of pursuing selfish concerns (and losing ourselves) to external happiness which is fleeing and unfulfilling. It seems contradictory , but according to Christ, it makes perfect sense.

¡Incluso la cosa más pequeña que hagamos por el Señor será recompensada. Jesús dice que "cualquiera que dé de beber solamente un vaso de agua fría a uno de estos pequeños, porque el pequeño es discípulo, de cierto os digo que no perderá su recompensa". Nuestro Señor quiere que demos libremente de nuestra abundancia a otros en necesidad como si le estuviéramos dando a Nuestro Señor mismo. De particular valor son las obras de misericordia corporales y espirituales. En estas obras prácticas, tenemos la oportunidad de ser como Cristo para los demás, no porque debamos hacerlo, sino porque queremos devolver libremente a Dios todo lo que Él nos ha dado. Dar de comer al hambriento, dar de beber al sediento, vestir al desnudo, dar cobijo a los desamparados, visitar a los enfermos y enterrar a los muertos, son las obras corporales (corporales). Los trabajos espirituales individuales se practican uno a uno, pero igual de poderosos. Estas obras son para instruir al ignorante, aconsejar al dudoso, consolar al afligido, amonestar al pecador, soportar los agravios con paciencia, perdonar todas las injurias y orar por los vivos y los muertos. Instruir a los niños en el catecismo es una excelente manera de practicar el primer trabajo y una buena manera de aprender la fe nosotros mismos. Enseñar a otros significa que nosotros mismos nos beneficiamos al reforzar lo leído, oído y escrito. Pedimos a nuestros estudiantes de Confirmación que practiquen todos estos trabajos a lo largo de sus dos años con nosotros. Solo sirviendo a los demás aprendemos a servir a Dios, a pensar de manera altruista y a salir de nosotros mismos. Al hacer por los demás, nos "encontramos a nosotros mismos", en lugar de perseguir preocupaciones egoístas (y perdemos a nosotros mismos) a la felicidad externa que es fugitiva e insatisfactoria. Parece contradictorio, pero según Cristo, tiene perfecto sentido.
