Catechism Corner by Kacey Carey, DRE

Today's gospel has a two-fold understanding. Jesus says He will reveal the Father to those that accept his yolk. Secondly, only those who are meek and "little" will this be revealed, not the "wise and the learned". Well, what exactly is this hidden treasure? The Kingdom of God will be hidden from the proud, arrogant and unyielding because they lack faith. Jesus calls those burdened by life to become healed by accepting His yolk of faith. The yolk of faith makes carrying burdens easier. This seems a contradiction, yet is not. Recall that in previous gospels, Jesus healed those who had great faith and belief that He could heal them. Do we go to the Lord in meekness, humility and gentleness? Or do we often say to the Lord: I will "say prayers" to you, now give me what I want? Some treat God like a gumball machine: I put in a prayer or light a candle, now give me what I want. This "fairy Godfather" approach is telling God to do our will, not His. This is the exact opposite of how we should approach God. Our Catechism says anyone who wants to believe and have faith needs a heart that is ready to listen. God is always speaking to us through human encounters, moving experiences, apparent coincidence, suffering, and in every challenge. These "hidden" messages are designed to teach us, strengthen our faith and understand that only belief in Him will surmount our problems. True faith means we trust and learn about God, read His word, form our consciences rightly and accept His will without reservation. Faith for salvation, is a gift from God, which we receive when we freely and fervently ask . It grows when we listen carefully to His word and enter a lively exchange with him in prayer.

Rincón de Catecismo por Kacey Carey, DRE

¡El evangelio de hoy tiene un doble entendimiento. Jesús dice que Él revelará al Padre a aquellos que acepten su yema. En segundo lugar, esto se revelará sólo a los mansos y "pequeños", no a los "sabios y eruditos". Bueno, ¿qué es exactamente este tesoro escondido? El Reino de Dios estará escondido de los soberbios, arrogantes e inflexibles por falta de fe. Jesús llama a los agobiados por la vida a ser sanados aceptando su yema de fe. La yema de la fe hace más fácil llevar las cargas. Esto parece una contradicción, pero no lo es. Recuerde que en los evangelios anteriores, Jesús sanó a aquellos que tenían gran fe y creencia de que Él podía sanarlos. ¿Vamos al Señor con mansedumbre, humildad y mansedumbre? ¿O decimos a menudo al Señor: te "diré oraciones", ahora dame lo que quiero? Algunos tratan a Dios como una máquina de chicles: pongo una oración o enciendo una vela, ahora dame lo que quiero. Este enfoque de "hada padrino" le está diciendo a Dios que haga nuestra voluntad, no la suya. Esto es exactamente lo contrario de cómo debemos acercarnos a Dios. Nuestro Catecismo dice que cualquiera que quiera creer y tener fe necesita un corazón que esté listo para escuchar. Dios siempre nos habla a través de los encuentros humanos, de las experiencias conmovedoras, de las coincidencias aparentes, del sufrimiento y en cada desafío. Estos mensajes "ocultos" están diseñados para enseñarnos, fortalecer nuestra fe y entender que solo creer en Él superará nuestros problemas. La verdadera fe significa que confiamos y aprendemos acerca de Dios, leemos Su palabra, formamos nuestras conciencias correctamente y aceptamos Su voluntad sin reservas. La fe para salvación, es un don de Dios, que recibimos cuando pedimos libre y fervientemente. Crece cuando escuchamos atentamente su palabra y entramos en un vivo intercambio con él en la oración. "Fe significa soportar la incomprendibilidad de Dios durante toda la vida". Carlos Rahner

*****English Catechism grades 1-7 are on 3 levels of skill: beginning sacramental preparation (A grades) teaches children how to pray, not merely rote praying, learning the life of Jesus and how He intervenes in our lives. First Communion (B grades) teach the importance of the Eucharist, understanding the sacraments and morally learning right from wrong. All C grades are advanced post Communion and further our understanding of Catholicism, character development and Christian life of virtue and service. All Catechism classes include a monthly parent training meeting such as Parental Rights; Helping our children become Saints; Eucharistic Revival and the family; and Keeping Our Kids Catholic.
